## Importance of EDI ✓

EDI or Electronic Data Interchange enables the exchange of commercial transactions between the IT systems of parties in business transactions.


The standardized nature of these documents is the major difference between EDI and other information exchange systems: Orders, shipment information, delivery notices, invoices, price lists, etc., can be electronically shared between different partners thanks to the use of a common language that lets the different information systems interact with each other.

EDICOM's technological solutions allow automatic transaction processing and validation thanks to their ability to interact with nearly all of the Internal Management Systems or ERPs on the market so that the documents are processed transparently with no human intervention.

**The portal is available in ASP-SaaS mode, so that all the technological resources needed (Software and Hardware) to get the solution up and running are outsourced through the EDICOM B2B Cloud Platform.**

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## Operation ✓


The “**Edicom WebPortal**” service is designed to enable web frameworks where business partners without an EDI solution can exchange documents like orders, electronic invoices, contracts and any other in-house or external commercial, administrative or logistical documentation electronically and securely.

The portal can be accessed via the web with a user name and password. Inside the portal, the user can receive and create documents using predefined templates.

These templates include checking mechanisms and customizations to ensure that the information recorded by the business partners is correct and contains the minimum data needed to carry out the transaction smoothly.

After recording the data in the web portal, a structured business document is processed and sent to the EDI solution, where our multi-format mapping service translates the document into the data structure required for ERP integration.
